Eligible candidates must provide a letter of proof of employment in order to verify the student's affiliation with the United Nations or embassy. These partial scholarships cover 50 percent of tuition for the M.A. in Government and Politics or the Advanced Certificates in International Law and Diplomacy or Public Administration.

The Pope Paul VI Scholarship began in 1965. Since then, the University has awarded more than 4 million in scholarship aid.

The M.A. or advanced certificates allow students to experience a rigorous academic environment combined with the opportunity to strengthen important practical skills. The program is designed to be flexible, allowing students to develop depth and breadth in their field.
